Worship Leader

We are looking for a Worship Leader who is passionate about their faith and is excited about leading God's people in music during worship.

Summary

- In cooperation with the *Worship Planning Committee*, responsible for:
 - leadership in worship planning and worship leading for Sunday contemporary, Grace Point mid-week, and other special services.
 - taking the worship experience to a new level of innovation and excellence.
 - helping church to explore and use a wide range of emerging and contemporary worship music, languages and expressions.
 - recruiting, coordinating, training, scheduling, directing and leading the spiritual formation of a team of staff and volunteers in music, audio-visual, and logistical support.

Core Responsibilities:

- Responsible for working with instrumentalists and vocalists
 - Train, Rehearse, Recruit, Evaluate
- Responsible for leading worship
 - Verbal transitions as needed to reinforce the theme or worship element
 - Engaging the congregation to help them move spiritually and physically from static to enthusiastic participants
 - Providing suggestions for congregational songs and specials which reinforce the worship theme
- Be sufficiently aware of the plans for the worship service and script to “carry” the service when needed

Specific Responsibilities:

- Lead instrumental and vocal rehearsals and practices
- Select vocalists for specific songs for Sunday contemporary worship and Grace Point mid-week services
- Meet and work with *Worship Planning Committee* weekly in planning for and designing worship

- Ability to work with professional (paid) as well as volunteer instrumentalists and vocalists to create the highest quality worship experience
- Ability to work in team situations
